**Arrangements for the continuation of the suspension of face-to-face classes  
and on-campus activities until 6<sup>th</sup> March**

Dear Parents/ Guardians,

The Education Bureau has announced that owing to the COVID-19 epidemic situation, all kindergartens, primary schools, secondary schools and tutorial schools will continue the suspension of face-to-face classes and on-campus activities until 6<sup>th</sup> March. Due to the teaching restrictions of online classes, please take note of the details below:

1	<p><u>Online classes</u></p> <p>Online classes will be maintained from 16<sup>th</sup> February to 6<sup>th</sup> March, and class times will remain unchanged.</p>									
2	<p><u>Arrangements for submitting and collecting homework</u></p> <p>In order to regularly review students' homework and understand their learning progress, the school will arrange for students at all levels to hand-in their homework on the following three days. It is recommended that parents come to the school to hand-in homework for their children. 3	<p><u>The Second Term examination and the Primary 6 second term internal assessment for the Central Allocation under Secondary School Places Allocation 2022 will be suspended.</u></p> <p>In view of the announcement by the Education Bureau that primary schools will continue the suspension of face-to-face classes, school activities, the Primary 6 second term internal assessment for the Central Allocation under Secondary School Places</p>									

	Allocation 2022, and the Second Term examinations for Primary 1 to Primary 6 will be suspended. The school will issue the examination papers for each subject in mid-March. It will be given to students as a learning assessment without scoring.
4	<p><u>Arrangements for the Discretionary Places</u></p> <p>Following the arrangements in 2020, under which the P.6 Second Term internal assessments were also cancelled due to the epidemic, the allocation band of this year's affected Primary 6 students will be determined by their internal assessment scores obtained at the end of P.5 and the mid-year of P.6, the Education Bureau has announced. Please pay attention to the Discretionary Places of the secondary schools your child has applied for. Please contact the class teacher with any queries.</p>
5	<p><u>The Territory-wide System Assessment for P.3 &amp; P.6 will be suspended</u></p> <p>The Education Bureau has announced that since the epidemic situation is still severe, the Territory-wide System Assessment 2022 will be suspended.</p>
6	<p><u>Pay attention to students' emotions</u></p> <p>Parents are kindly requested to pay more attention to their children's mood while they are studying at home. If you need assistance, please call the school and contact the social worker (Ms. Cheung) as soon as possible.</p>
7	<p><u>Support for online learning</u></p> <p>The Incorporated Management Committee will provide online learning support (a data card) to students who are unable to take online classes effectively due to network instability or family economic impact. Applicants must be full-subsidised students or families with financial difficulties and they can contact the Vice Principal Ms Fan to apply.</p>

Since the epidemic situation is still severe, we would like to appeal to parents to avoid letting their children go to crowded and poorly-ventilated public places in order to avoid the risk of infection. And we must maintain a balanced diet, regular exercise and adequate rest to enhance immunity. If the situation changes, the school will adopt appropriate measures accordingly. We ask that parents pay close attention to all messages issued by the school and announcements from the Education Bureau (EDB).
