Application for Cross-Net Allocation
(First Batch)

Dear Parents,

The Education Bureau is now accepting applications for Cross-Net Allocation for this academic year. All Primary 6 students who need to change their school district due to relocation or the difference between their residential area and the school's location are eligible to apply. To better allocate school places in each district to meet the actual needs of the placement, parents are requested to submit their applications to the school according to their actual situation and complete the Cross-Net Allocation Application Form (Attachment 1) together with the relevant supporting documents to the class teacher on or before January 5, 2026.

If parents have registered as users of the "Secondary 1 Allocation Electronic Platform" and have bound their accounts with "Smart ID+", they may also submit cross-net applications through the platform from now until January 16, 2026. Please note that parents can only apply through one of the above methods and should not submit duplicate applications. All cross-net allocation placement lists will be announced in late January; if there are still parents who need to apply, the deadline for the last batch of cross-net allocation applications will also be in early March.

If a student who is to be placed has previously submitted an application for "Self-Allocation of Secondary Places" to one or two secondary schools before knowing about the relocation and needs to cancel the application, please cancel the application in writing to the relevant secondary school and return a copy to the school for record.

Documents to be submitted

1. Proof of Address: For example, a stamped tenancy agreement, rates bill, electricity bill, water bill, public housing tenancy agreement/lease certificate, fixed-line telephone bill, etc. (The proof of address must be in the name of the parent/guardian.)
2. Photocopy of the parent/guardian's HK Identity Card with "COPY" stamped or written on it.
3. Photocopy of the student's birth certificate or HK Identity Card with "COPY" stamped or written on it.
